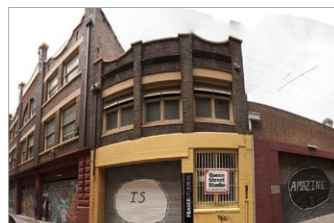
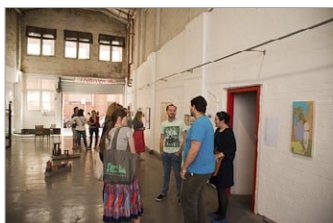

Also happening at Assemblage (42 Kensington Street); come and observe the designers and artists working away in the studio workshop spaces. In the downstairs exhibition pin up space, AR-MA will be holding workshops for creatives exploring new digital algorithmic design tools. In the workshop spaces live demonstrations of laser cutting, foam milling and 3D scanning will be held throughout the day.

Queen Street Studio is a not for profit arts organisation who has been providing free and subsidised space to artists in Sydney over the last six years. So far, **QSS** has provided over 150 visual arts residencies, 38 performing arts residencies and 19 new script developments.
