## **Queen Street Studio announces final FraserStudios Visual Arts residents for 2011.**

Twenty-three emerging and established Visual Artists and collectives have been chosen to undertake a three- or six-month residency at **FraserStudios** between May and November of 2011.

The Visual Artists — who were selected from over fifty applications — will be working on a diverse range of projects and practices, including hybrid disciplines such as live art and performance art, large-scale and moving image installations, painting, drawing, photography and multimedia work. A number of the artists plan to respond to the local Chippendale area and use recycled and found objects from the local urban landscape in their practice.

The coveted six-month residency for emerging artists (defined as artists in the first five years of their professional practice) has gone to local collective **Team MESS**, who work across the performing and visual arts and use public and everyday events as a frame for their work. **Team MESS** are **Dara Gill, Sime Knezevic, Frank Mainoo, Natalie Randall** and **Malcolm Whittaker**. They join **Agathe Gothe-Snape, Brown Council** and **Mitch Cairns** as artists who have received six-month residencies at FraserStudios since 2008.
