AWARDS

The team effort of a professional photographer and filmmaker with a group of teenage parents to produce a film with a positive health message has been honoured in the **Australian Business Art Foundation's NSW awards**.

The project, between South East Arts Region and the Southern General Practice Network, was among last night's winners for the foundation's state awards, which recognise partnerships between businesses and arts organisations.

Another winning project was the union between Renew Newcastle and the property development company GPT Group to use vacant buildings in Newcastle for artists and other creative enterprises.

A similar project between Frasers Property and Queen Street Studio, using empty space in Chippendale as artists' studios, is among the national finalists. It will join five others vying for awards in Sydney on October 21.
